

### Conditions of Entry

1. The organisers' decision is final.
2. The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel any class, refuse any entry or disqualify a competitor at any time and for any reason they deem sufficient.
3. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event at short notice in adverse ground or weather conditions. Entry fees, less £3.00 for administration, will be refunded or alternative date given.
4. Following the closing date, entry fees for withdrawals will only be refunded on production of a veterinary/medical certificate.
5. Competitors eliminated or retiring at any obstacle may continue on the course at judges discretion but must give way to following competitors.  
No competitor will be allowed more than 3 attempts at any one obstacle.
6. No misuse of the whip or spurs.
7. All horses and ponies to be four years and over.
8. **Skull Caps** (PASO 15 1988 or 2011, BS EN1384 1997, EN 1384 1996) must be worn and with the harness correctly fastened at all times whilst mounted. Please note BS4472 is no longer accepted at riding club competitions.
9. Correct hunting or cross country dress and footwear must be worn.
10. **Back protectors** Beta Level 3, purple label manufactured 2000 or after and medical armbands are compulsory.
12. Objections must be handed in to the secretary in writing, within half an hour of the results of the event, together with a deposit of £10 which will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
13. The organisers and landowners accept no responsibility for any claim in respect of damage, loss or accident to any person, competitor, onlooker, animal, vehicle or property howsoever caused in connection with or arising from the event.
14. Horses can be easily frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public and spectators are requested to keep clear of horse lanes/areas and to avoid behavior which may alarm horses.
15. Competitors should be aware that riding is a risk sport and should not attempt to ride in any class that is beyond their experience or ability.
16. **All dogs must be kept under close control and on a lead at all times.**

### Health and Safety

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all judges, officials and stewards.
