Classes 5–7 will be a single round. Second half of the course will be timed. Provided first section is clear, places will be determined by faults and time in the second half.

Time permitting: Open Clear Round jumping until 3pm
Height of jumps will be determined by entrants.
Entry fee £5.00 a round or £7.00 for two rounds

Rules: Knock Down: 4 Faults. 1st Refusal: 4 Faults, 2nd Refusal: 8 Faults, 3rd Refusal: Elimination. Fall of Horse or Rider: Elimination

Conditions of Entry

- Hard hats must be worn at all times with a harness properly adjusted and fastened; skull cap hats must be worn with silks. Hats are recommended to be the following standard: PAS O15(1998 or 2011), ASTM F1163 (2004), BSEN 1384 (1997) EN 1384 (1996) SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 (2003 or 2006). Body protectors are recommended and **MUST be worn on the cross-country course**, Beta Level 3 (purple label) which has been manufactured in 2000 or after.
- Liability – the organisers or anyone acting on their behalf accept no liability whatsoever for loss, injury, or damage to any animal, property, persons, or vehicle however caused.
- Objections must be handed in to the secretary in writing, within half an hour of the event, together with a deposit of £20. The deposit will be forfeited if the show officials decide the objection is not sustained.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason and to cancel/alter the time of any class, also to run any class in another ring.
- The management reserves the right to limit the entries in any class.
